As a Realtor, I am always asked what a homeowner can do to make their home's value increase. I am rarely asked about remodeling without the above question being asked in unison. Most homeowners feel they need to justify their remodeling adventures by increasing their investment.

Each year, the National Association of Realtors compiles a report narrowing these two thoughts into an informative resource giving a quantitative reason for remodeling along with Realtors' opinions on increasing a home's value.

Only 18% of homeowners remodeled because it was time for a change. With 34% of homeowners remodeling because of worn-out surfaces, finishes and materials. The report ranks projects according to Realtors' ranking of projects appeal to buyers and according to the likely value to the home for resale.

How many do-it-yourselfers do we have out there? 36% of homeowners **did the project themselves** with the rest contracted the job out.

The most important reason for remodeling: after remodeling 74% of owners have a greater desire to be IN THEIR home.
