

To even have enough kids to form a team, every boy in his class had to agree to play. For the last two years, this team's head coach was one of the parents and having no coaching experience, some people just find their spot.

My son started to play basketball in the 5th grade, at a larger school. Gavin had liked basketball and joined the team until after one practice the coach said he didn't seem to have a strong interest in playing. Gavin didn't say much but decided to quit after the next practice. At this smaller school, all the boys were needed to make a team, good or bad.

Last week's practice was probably to be the last if this team didn't win the next game to stay in the Championship Tournament. At the beginning of practice, Coach started a drill where each player would do a layup and the second player would pass the ball while running back in rotation as fast



as they could. I did notice this drill was lasting a long time and the sweat was starting to roll. The team was hot, frustrated and exhausted, but Coach just stood watching so the drill would continue. T he whistle blew, after an amount of time I was unsure of, and the coach yelled, "FINALLY 10 BASKETS IN A ROW! Gather around." He said, "I didn't tell you what I was looking for because I shouldn't have to tell you what I am looking for. Only two of you kept trying the whole time and did not give up." He went on to explain,

"It took an hour and seven minutes for each of you to care about what you were doing.

It took an hour and seven minutes for each of you to **do your best at the same time.**

It took an hour and seven minutes to **make 10 baskets in a row.** It took an hour and seven minutes for you to **act as a TEAM."**

¹ hat practice did turn out to be the team's last practice. The Jaguars played in the Championship Tournament which they started in the last bracket. They did not win to continue, but each and every member of that

team had significant plays. It was a real nail-biter until the last seconds when one more shot would have won the game.

After the game, the parents started texting each other and this was sent to the whole group by our coach.



This quote is from the movie, "Remember the Titans" and is what the coach said about a player's lack of ability...

"Don't you dare say sorry, he was wonderful in his own

way. He added an amazing amount of value. The most important thing is that he learned and grew from it. Made memories for when he is 40 years old and broken down like me! His smile was contagious, and he was always there for his team. Every single young man on this team added value in their own way. I can speak in-depth and each and every one of them for anyone that doubts me. Long story short is I know you are their parent but as their coach, I always have their back, even when they are 40."

T here is a new basketball goal in our back driveway where Gavin has spent around an hour every night, since that last practice, with headphones on making baskets. His strong talents are in science, and high school is next year where to get on the team would be nearly impossible. He must have known it was the last practice for him. It all must have meant something.














Memory Lane


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315 Fox Creek Road

With thick stone, chimney tops peaking towards the sky and large porches overlooking Hermann, the sunny day was showcasing their beauty. Looking back today, that day started a desire to learn more about these enchanting pieces of Hermann real estate.



Several years passed before we found ourselves in Hermann for an evening of going through Hermann's downtown shops with our kiddos. When we walked to the edge of town and looked up the hill, there were those stone cottages placed just perfectly like a painted picture. This




time, when we were done looking around, we just had to find how to get closer to them. We drove a hidden one-lane road winding around from the back and popped out at the first cottage. We sat there with our car




Kristina and Scott's List of Favorites:

- <u>Hermannhof Cottages</u> (also referred to as the Weinhouse Cottages) Stay in the "Champagne Room" in the Hermann Haus.
- Saleigh Mountain Company Leather Shop This is a MUST GO. Tell Sally and Molly we said hello.
- <u>Stomp'n Grounds Coffee Shop</u> Everything is locally received from little towns across Missouri. The Croissant (ham and egg) is fabulous. We sat at the window to watch the happenings of this small town and worked on our computers. Love the atmosphere and restored downtown space!



- <u>TinMill Steakhouse</u> Have the Chocolate Cake. Actually take it back to the room, as I did in the picture. It lasts several nights in the mini-fridge.
- <u>Fernweh Distilling Co.</u> Very cool atmosphere to relax in, but it is closed (off-season) during the week.
- <u>Ricky's Chocolate Box</u> Walk right in and Ricky is making the chocolate goodies all day. There are cases and cases of all kinds of chocolates. Try the chocolate turtles with the toffee on top, and bring one back for me!
- <u>Wings A-Blazin</u>' This place has the best wings and it's 2 doors down from the Saleigh Mountain Company Leather Shop. Also, we did not get to try it, but there is a Cupcake Shop right next door that is new. (Looked really special...next trip!)
 - **Battocletti's Bake Shoppe** This is right beside Ricky's Chocolate Box. I stumbled across them because I felt bad I had parked in front of their store and then walked past to go to the chocolate place. So...on the way back, I went in. You must go in too. Get the homemade cinnamon bread that is round and take it home.

Greystained custom cabinets from J&J Cabinetry accents the wood allowing both grey and brown tones to combine. The master bedroom has a tiled shower, double sinks and a walk-in closet. A full downstairs with 3rd car garage is ready for your expansion. Come see!

















This time, I took my I3-year-old son to get a special Christmas present. I wanted to get him a special backpack that would be a keepsake and get better looking as it aged through the years. It was a special day when Gavin and I drove down on his last day of Christmas Break. After we picked out the perfect backpack, Gavin and I drove around the corner and there were those cottages on the hill. I guess it was the mood of Christmas, but I actually called when we returned home and booked one for the end of February.

Each cottage is a fully restored historic house, originally built in the mid-1800s. They are owned by the Hermannhof Winery and referred to as the Weinhaus Cottages. Each guest room is classic to luxury and each is designed with exquisite style to offer you choices, which include magnificent bedchamber, wine cellars, sitting rooms, fireplaces, oversized claw-foot soaking tubs, extensive multi-stream showers, and wrap-around porches.

After looking at picture after picture, we picked the Champagne Room in the Hermann Haus Building. This structure has 2 rooms with the Champaign

Room on the top-level, so it is very private. It is also the last cottage on the hill and the one you see in most of the pictures.

This would be the first time I had ever spent more than a few hours in Hermann. When we checked in and drove to our cottage, we could not believe how beautiful the setting was. It really is the best cottage due to the massive, panoramic view. When entering the






room, 2 fireplaces set the mood of complete tranquility. The bathroom takes up half the cottage with a fireplace of its own. The double bedroom doors open up to the expansive back porch with the lit town below. At night, we would relax with the back door cracked to let the fresh air and train sounds absorb our cottage.

We were worried about going on their off-

season, but this is the best time, in our opinion. Everything is open and the restaurants, wineries, shops, tours, and massage companies are all available. We had always felt we had to go further away to feel really relaxed, and it was one of the best vacations we have ever taken. We think it's one of the best-kept secrets around, and it's a good thing kids are not allowed at these cottages (wink, wink).
